

## **File Description**

This document constitutes a File Description for the purposes of Sections 10 and 24 of the Finnish Personal Data Act (523/1999; as amended).

### **3. Name of the Data File**

The user register of the controller's gaming software ("Software")

### **4. Purpose of Processing Personal Data**

Personal data collected from the users of the Software is used mainly only to the extent necessary in order to enable the normal operation, customer informing and general maintenance and development of the Software.

In addition, the content of the user register may be used to marketing and to general communication between us and the registered user. The marketing functions play minor role and the user can prohibit marketing at any time by sending us email (see contact details above).

The Software is governed by the terms of use which every user needs to accept.

### **5. Data Content**

The user register contains the basic information of each user account, i.e. the password of the account and the user name and the user's email address, as well as other details, such as user generated content such as pictures taken by user. Moreover, the necessary information to customer service, such as feedback, communication history and possible direct marketing bans may be stored in the user register.

The personal data of the users is stored for a period that is necessary for the maintenance of the Software and the customer relationship. Use of the Software is not possible without certain information, such as user name and password. We, however, remove the personal data upon request. All requests of prohibition and deleting the personal data files should be sent to us by email (see contact details above).

The user register does not contain other personal data than set out above.

### **6. Regular Sources of Information**

The data used by the user register of the Software is acquired directly from the registered users as they provide us with the necessary information to enable the use of the Software.

## **7. Data Disclosure and Transfer outside European Union**

We may disclose personal data to the extent allowed and/or mandated by the terms of use, or law. As a rule, personal data is not disclosed to third parties in any other than for the above purposes, unless otherwise stated by law. Personal data in the user register of the Software may be transferred outside the EU, as authorized by the users by accepting the terms of use.

## **8. Protection of the Data File**

The user register of the Software is protected by technical and physical safeguards. There are no manual copies of the user register. The databases are protected against security breaches by firewalls, passwords and by other technical means. In addition, the databases and their backups are located in locked and supervised facilities.

## **9. Review, Prohibition and Rectification Right**

In accordance with the Finnish Personal Data Act, registered user has the right to access his/her data file in order to review what information concerning him/her has been recorded in the register. Moreover, the user as data subject has the right to prohibit us from disclosing or processing his/her personal data, and request for rectification of any erroneous data. Most of the personal data in the user register is accessible and rectifiable to users themselves in connection with the Software. All requests of access, prohibition or rectification may however also be made to us by email (see contact details above).

## **10. Other Rights of the User Regarding the Processing of Personal Data**

In addition to the above, the registered user has the right to prohibit us from processing his/her personal data for purposes of direct advertising, distance selling, other direct marketing, market research and opinion polls.
